- Bringing the effect of obedience and disobedience back to your own life experiences.

Attention should also be given to:

- Illegitimate authority
- How to discern illegitimate authority
- Using biblical examples of illegitimate authority.

Be bold to follow the pattern scripture gives us.

**Body:**

Write 1 – 2 paragraphs

Give examples from your own life

**How disobedience has affected my own life:**

Write 1 – 2 paragraphs

Give examples from your own life.

Write 1 paragraph, tying the assignment together.
