**Focus on the following when recording your testimony:**

- Your life before you received Jesus Christ (Fear, condemnation, guilt).
- Your life after you have accepted Jesus Christ (Freedom based on what Jesus has done, I'm no longer a slave to fear, I am a child of God).
- Your assurance that you have eternal life through what Jesus has done for you.
